



<p><b>5. Cash for Clothes</b></p>	<p>EP has booked Bobscash4clothes for 1.3.19 and we will be paid 50p/ Kilo. Summer Fayre</b></p>	<p>Friday 29.6.19</p> <p>CD has enquired about hiring ponies from Gillian's Riding School. £220 for two ponies for two hours plus hats etc. CD will check that Gillian's have their own licence. Ponies need to be sited away from inflatables and children using footballs. There needs to be a quick turnaround and adults to help lift children onto the ponies. 5 mins/ child including getting on/off horse. We can expect to do 48 rides in the time, so it's proposed to sell tickets in advance only and to book people in for half hour slots. Booking to be done via School Office. Tickets to cost £3/ child.</p> <p>EP has enquired about inflatables/ rides. Beeline charge £665 to include Teacups, 3 inflatables, generator and pins. Teacups hold 15 at a time. Chairplanes cost £400 on their own and hold 20 at a time. CD said that Katie's Kastles would do 4 inflatables for £275 and also come with a generator. CD to check about fencing and size of inflatables. A generator might not now be necessary since the new nursery building has electricity points and the inflatables don't use very much electric.</p> <p>Decision to book Katie's Kastles package for £275 plus get Chairplanes.
